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### **Minutes of a meeting of Sandown Town Council Environment Committee held on Monday 14 August 2017 at 6.00pm at Business Hub College Close, Sandown**

Having expressed an interest in the Environment Committee, Cllr. Grandchamp was co-opted to the Committee.

**014/17 To receive and accept apologies for absence**  
No apologies were received

**015/17 To receive declarations of interest**  
There were no declarations of interest

**016/17 To agree and sign the minutes of the meeting held on 17 July 2017**  
After making one amendment the minutes of the meeting held on 17 July 2017 were approved and signed.

**017/17 To discuss and make recommendations to Full Council re:-**  
Public Toilets – Pier Street. It was agreed as discussed at the last meeting that Pier Street toilets needed to be kept going until the end of the season.

*6.25pm Cllr. Patel joined the meeting*

Cllr. Grandchamp suggested that perhaps the money from Sandham Grounds bank account could be used to fund the extra expense.

It was agreed that temporary toilets would be needed for high season periods next year if the Town Council was either not offered or did not accept the freehold offer from the IOW Council, and the toilets were closed. It was suggested that Wayne Peake be approached to provide cover out of the periods when temporary toilets were used. It was suggested that the Town Council approach the IOW Council with a view to siting them in the 'no car zone' in front of the Pier

The toilets were not kept open late on Regatta night, but they would be in November as the Carnival Committee had already reminded the Clerk.

We need to try to assess the materials used, and how much extra is used on late nights.

The quotes from Danfo need to be re-visited.

It was noted that Eastern gardens was now free of pigeons, and the Clerk was asked about reports that someone had used a gun on them. She assured Councillors that

she knew nothing about it and that none of the Staff would have been involved in such a thing.

One of the members of the Public was invited to speak and Ian Boyd asked about S106 monies and the use of it.

Sandham Gardens – lease from IOW Council now agreed and its legal department was drawing up the revised lease. This will enable the lease between Sandown TC and Heritage to be signed as soon as it can be.

Revetment – cycling was deferred to the next meeting

Ski Jets – we need to find out how many get hired out.
